Buy, Sell & Trade a Foal

Foals attending the Festival and competing in the Championship do <u>not</u> have to be offered for sale or trade in the Irish Warmblood Marketplace.

Foals for Sale

WSI will market and promote your foal. We will encourage prospective buyers to attend the Festival. At the Festival we will introduce potential purchasers to you, and you and the prospective purchaser can discuss your foal in a private conversation. Foals must be shown at the Festival and inspected by the judges for the Championship. There are no additional fees or commissions associated with selling your foal through the Marketplace at the Irish Warmblood Festival.

Provide one or more high quality photos of your foal and we also will promote it from 1 October – 30 November on the online Irish Warmblood Marketplace connected to WSI's homepage. A video clip also may be submitted. WSI reserves the right not to publish photos and/or videos if the quality is not sufficient. There are no additional fees or commissions associated with selling your foal through the online Marketplace.

Foals for Trade

Sometimes breeders need to diversify their bloodlines by adding a new filly. And sometimes a breeder would rather have a colt (to retain as a stallion prospect or as a gelding for sport) than the filly their mare produced. To accommodate these breeders WSI will offer a Foals for Trade service this year. If you have a foal you would like to trade please indicate this on the Festival Entry form. WSI will compile a list of foals available to be traded and share the list only with fellow Irish Warmblood breeders with foals to trade. Foals to be traded must be shown at the Festival and inspected by the judges for the Championship. There are no additional fees or commissions associated with trading your foal through the Festival's Marketplace.
