Tresor d'Opaline had a very successful career in international showjumping with Jean-Claude Van Geenberghe (Belgium) and later with Samantha Lam (Hong Kong),

who competed him in the 2008 Olympics. He won the Grand Prix of Lummen, Dinard, Lons le Saunier, and Vittel. He was a member of the Belgium Teams that placed 2nd in the Nationals Cup of Rotterdam, 3rd in the Nations Cup of Lummen, and 7th in the Nations Cup of both Gijon and Rome. In 2006 he was ranked as the 50th best showjumper in the world.

Breeding: Tresor d'Opaline descends from one of the greatest dams in showjumping history: Opaline des Pins. From five different sires this mare produced five international showjumping stallions, and three of them competed in the Olympics: Tresor d'Opaline (2008 Olympics), Quintus (2008 Olympics), Jus de Pomme (1996 Olympic Gold Medal winner), Shogoun II (1st World Cup qualifier at Geneva), Richebourg (3rd World Cup qualifier at Vigo). Because of his sport career Tresor d'Opaline did not service many mares but nevertheless in 2008 he was ranked 26th in the Belgium showjumping index. His international showjumping progeny include Apple Juice, Athos, and Elias. The Warmblood Studbook of Ireland would be interested in hearing from breeders who have frozen semen from Tresor d'Opaline stored in their tanks and/or daughters of this stallion that descend from world-class damlines.

FOUNDATION DAMLINE PROFILE

WSI Damline 12 descends from KWPN family 23/ mareline 27 and is also known as the Lady Reveil-line. The foundation mares from this damline are Kalista (Burggraaf x Nooitgedacht), a Keur mare of the KWPN, and her 2007 daughter Cathleen ni Houlihan m2s (by Ulysses m2s). Kalista's first foal was the AWS-approved stallion Odin, which stands in the USA and competed in Level 7 showjumping. Her second foal, the filly Soliste, received the Sport-Showjumping predicate from the KWPN. Another daughter, Walista, is a Ster mare. Kalista's 2004 son Ziggy Marley m2s (by Roven xx) has begun a successful eventing career in Ireland with international rider Katie O'Sullivan. Her 2009 WSI-registered son Air China m2 (by the international showjumper Wang Chung m2s) was named a Star Foal and was sold and exported to Germany. The damline has produced the international showjumpers Son of Blue (out of Kalista's half-sister Bernadine), Natasja, Aswinta, Cadillac-Z, Othello-S, Ewald, Vasalis GF, Lefleur, Laronia, Siroko,

Jasmijn S, Racy, Lesterette R, Medeo R, Notorious-Utopoa, Ralphy Utopia de Ransbeck, Corjulana, Ulano, Montgomery, Mobily Lil Majd, Val de Loir Imoo, Shadow Ter Putte, Poertwa, Rocky, Owen, Jolanda Utopia, Thomas, Tiqulja, Olav van het Hoogeinde, Nautilus, and Ojasper. This large and productive damline has also produced three dozen approved stallions; a number of international dressage horses including Dream of Heidelberg II, Del Vento, Leander, Uthopia, Jeff, and Jasper; and several international eventing horses.
