Eric Lamaze Is New Rider of Wang Chung m2s

The WSI-approved stallion Wang Chung m2s has a new rider: Eric Lamaze of Canada. Eric is the reigning Olympic champion, having won the Individual Gold Medal and Team Silver Medal at the 2008 Olympics on the KWPN stallion Hickstead, a grand-son of the deceased stallion Ekstein, the Honorary Foundation Stallion of the WSI. Eric is currently the world's top-ranked international showjumping rider.

Wang Chung m2s

(Royal Bravour - ster pref prest Harnita x Ahorn x Erdball xx x Marco Polo) is a 2003 stallion owned and bred by Morningside Stud. As a 4- and 5-year-old the chestnut was ridden by Eddie Brinkman of the Netherlands and the pair won the *Future Stallion* Championship at the CSI2* Zwolle show. From January 2009 until recently Wang Chung m2s was ridden by Felix Hassmann of Germany. This 8-year-old stallion has won or placed in 39 international showjumping classes up to 1.50 m.; won or placed in 27 national S classes up to 1.50 m.; and won the Bronze Medal in the German *Championat der Landesmeiste*. Currently Wang Chung m2s is ranked 488 in the world, is the third most highly ranked 2003 stallion in international showjumping, and overall is the world's 14th highest ranked 8-year-old showjumper.

WSI Genetics at the European Championship

Ninja la Silla, the gelded son of the WSI-recognized stallion Guidam, is the 2011 European Showjumping Champion with Swedish rider Rolf-Göran Bengtsson. The WSI-recognized stallion Cornet Obolensky won the Team Gold Medal and placed 11th in the individual final ranking with German rider Marco Kutscher.

Son of Ulysses m2s Selected for Lanaken

Millfield Ulymate has been selected to represent Great Britain at the FEI World Breeding Championship for Young Jumping Horses in Lanaken, Belgium. This 6-year-old gelding was sired by the WSI-approved stallion Ulysses m2s and is out of Condessa m2s (sired by the WSI-approved stallion Condios and out of the WSI-approved mare Odessa). As a 4-year-old this horse was the joint 4-Year-Old British Showjumping Champion and 5-Year-Old Vice-Champion.

Daughter of Condios on Irish Junior European Team

Kilminchy Condor, a 2002 mare sired by the WSI-approved stallion Condios, was on the Irish team that recently placed 4th in the European Championship for Junior Eventing Riders with Lucca Stubington.

Ballistic m2s and Boy Toy m2s Jumping Well

The 5-year-old WSI-approved stallions Ballistic m2s (Ekstein x Condios) and Boy Toy m2s (Ekstein x Limmerick), the first two stallions licensed by the WSI and performance tested in Germany, had good outdoor seasons with wins and placings with their German rider Lars Rethemeier.

Change in Radiographic Protocol

In consultation with the WSI Veterinary Committee radiographs of the front knees will now be added to the list of x-rays required for stallion licensure and approval.
