Cantoblanco received the following scores: Interior 8.5; Walk 8.13; Trot 7.38; Canter 8.63; Rideability 8.38; Jumping 9.38

Breeding: Cantoblanco was the Champion at the 2008 Holsteiner Stallion Approvals and he

convinced the jury and the crowd with his superb jumping technique, modern build and conformation, and athleticism. His sire, Canto, was himself Champion of the 2004 Holsteiner Approvals and is a son of the Olympic showjumper Canturo. Cantoblanco descends from one of the great Holsteiner motherlines, stamm 4965. This mare family has produced many international showjumpers including Zandor, Poor Boy, Sonora la Silla, Santana la Silla, and a number of athletes very closely related to Cantoblanco. For example, Cantoblanco's dam G-Casablanca is a full-sister to the international showjumpers and approved Holsteiner stallions Clinton I and Clinton II; she is also a full-sister to the international jumping gelding Clintus and the international jumping mare Hirtin, known in sport as Chica Bay and known in breeding as the dam of the international jumping stallion Levisto. FOUNDATION DAMLINE PROFILE

WSI Damline 5 descends from Hannoverian stamm 42, also known as Ackerwelle. The foundation mares in the WSI studbook are the deceased mare Pia (Calvados x Pilot x Beach Boy), a national-level showjumper that was days away from beginning to jump international 1.40 m. classes with Olympic rider Gert-Jan Bruggink when an accident while traveling ended her sport career; and her daughters Condia m2s (by Condios), the dam of the WSI 2009 Champion Filly Foal Adriana Lima m2s; Bumblebee Rose m2s (by Hornet Rose), and Cheng Pei-pei m2s (by Wang Chug m2s). Besides Pia her dam Impuls produced Nurjev, an international showjumping stallion; the international showjumping gelding Spike; and the Swedish Warmblood Studbook approved stallion Arandasj, which won the jumping portion of the stallion test in 2008.

DID YOU KNOW?

Following procedures specified by law on the first anniversary of WSI's approval as an EU studbook we

were inspected by an official from the Department of Agriculture to confirm our compliance with EU and Irish law and professional management of the studbook. Following this inspection the Minister could have rescinded our approval or granted further approval for one, two or three years. The WSI was delighted to receive from the Minister the maximum three-year renewal of our approval.

WSI HORSES IN GERMANY

In April six yearlings from the first crop of foals born into the Warmblood Studbook of Ireland traveled to their new home in Germany. The yearlings are the Champion Filly Foal Adriana Lima m2s (Desir du Chateau - Condia m2s x Condios), the Champion Colt Foal An Wang m2s (Wang Chung m2s - Vicky x Burggraaf), Afropop m2s (Desir du Chateau - Ozy Cruise m2s x Cruising), America Ferrera m2s (Desir du Chateau - Concordia m2s x Condios), the Star foal Air China m2s (Wang Chung m2s - Kalista x Burggraaf), and Asian Gold m2s (Wang Chung m2s - Emerald Cruising m2s x Cruising).
