OBSERVATIONS BY INSPECTION COMMITTEE: Modern, rectangular stallion with a nice expression. Pleasing eye. Well-muscled neck with good length. A little weak in his back and loins. Foreleg stance is over at the knee. Hindleg stance is sickle. Feet are sufficient but the heels are low. Quality of the legs is a bit blurred from his sport career. He has competed up to 1.55 m. level. In 2026 the stallion's first crop will be 8-years-old, and several already are competing in 1.40 – 1.45 m. competitions. He should suit a lot of mares in both showjumping and eventing breeding. For showjumping, the mare should have correct leg conformation and a good back and loins. He should improve the canter, rideability, and jumping technique. For eventing breeding, the mare should have a good walk and trot, and he should improve the canter and jumping traits. When paired with a distance-bred Thoroughbred or true half-bred mare, the stallion could produce 4* and 5* eventers.

Stage 2 veterinary exam is not required based on earlier approvals by studbooks with equivalent veterinary standards.

Stage 3 Performance Test is not required based on results in showjumping sport.
