3-DAY PERFORMANCE TEST OBSERVATIONS: Modern type that is slightly square and could have a more rectangular shape. His neck is well-muscled and a bit upright with good length. Pasterns are upright, especially in the forelegs. The forefeet are a bit different. The stance of the hindleg is a bit straight. The quality of the legs is sufficient. The walk is sufficient and active when he relaxes. The trot is sufficient but is fast and needs more shoulder freedom, body use, and elasticity. The hindleg is active. The canter is active and powerful, but a bit downhill. The length of stride is sufficient, and this is clearly revealed when he jumps combinations and handles distances easily. When jumping, the takeoff is sufficient. He is careful. He has good foreleg technique; his hindlegs should open more. He has sufficient scope. He likes to jump and work. The stallion has good potential for a dual sport and breeding career. He has a lot of blood in his body type and athleticism, and should suit a lot of mares. For showjumping breeding, the mare should bring a rectangular frame, a good canter, and power; the stallion is expected to bring a lot of blood, a willingness to work, and a lighter frame to his progeny. For eventing breeding, the mare should have good foreleg conformation and a long stride for the gallop. The stallion could produce 4* and 5* eventers when combined with a distance-bred Thoroughbred or true half-bred mare with three good gaits, endurance, and ability to produce a sustained gallop.
