3-DAY PERFORMANCE TEST OBSERVATIONS: This stallion is a full-brother to the successful sport stallion Dourkhan Hero Z, and he descends from an exceptionally good damline. He has stallion expression. He is a bit square, and his neck is a little vertical. His topline is a little weak. Stance of forelegs is good from the side; from the front he is a bit toed-out on both legs, on the right more than the left. His feet are a little different. His performance damline compensates easily for any weaknesses in his conformation. Walk is sufficient. Trot is elastic with a normal length of stride; he should have more shoulder freedom as his shoulder is a bit straight. Canter is light-footed with good balance. Rideability should be better, but he is only three-years-old and hopefully it will improve with training and development. He needs to concentrate more and work through his back more. Jumps powerfully with a good takeoff; front legs are a little open at times; hind-leg technique is consistently good. Seems to have good scope and quick reflexes. He wants to jump and works willingly. He is a stallion with a lot of potential for sport and breeding, and in breeding he is appropriate for both showjumping and eventing directions. He is likely to be best paired with long-lined mares with good toplines, feet, and basic gaits. He should contribute blood and jumping ability to his progeny. For eventing breeding, the mare should possess three good gaits and good rideability.
