3-DAY PERFORMANCE TEST OBSERVATIONS: This stallion is a son of the successful sport stallion Dourkhan Hero Z, and he descends from the direct damline of Liscalgot (the stallion's third dam), who was World Champion with Dermott Lennon. The stallion's damsire is the WSI Recognised Stallion Agana van het Gerendal Z, currently one of the best showjumpers in the USA. This is a well-developed stallion. He is a little rectangular. His neck is somewhat vertical and ewe-shaped, but when he is concentrating on jumping he often drops his head and neck. His back and loins are a little weak. Stance of his four legs is good, and his legs are dry. Hind-leg is a bit long. Walk is sufficient, but slightly toed-in. Trot is functional with good posture. Canter is powerful with good carriage, length of stride, and balance. Jumps with a very good takeoff; makes a good bascule; and uses his body well. His hind-leg technique is consistently good while his front-leg technique can vary. He has exceptional scope and a lot of talent as a jumping horse. He is rideable, but sometimes distracted. He is pre-disposed to work with his rider. This stallion shows much potential for both sport and breeding, and the latter for both showjumping and eventing. Mares always should bring good neck conformation with respect to both position and muscling. For eventing breeding, care should be taken to use him with mares with a very good walk and good rideability. Because of this stallion's potential, the Stallion Committee waived the requirement that the pedigree be complete for 5-generations with no missing ancestors. (Liscalgot's second dam is unknown.)
