Additional Observations by the Inspectors: The stallion has developed very nicely since his Stage 1 inspection in the spring, and he is sufficiently developed for his age. The stance of his forelegs is normal, but he is toed-out, particularly in the front left. The hindleg is normal. His feet are a little wide and heels a little low. The walk is a little toed-out. The walk and trot are regular and sufficient. The length of his canter stride is good and with normal impulsion and balance, but at times he is on the forehand. He is a little better balanced on the left lead. At times he is behind the bit. When jumping he uses his body well, jumps easily, and shows more than good technique both front and behind. He is careful and shows good scope. He is attentive to his rider, has good rideability, and he likes to work. His interior qualities are more than good. His pedigree and damline are excellent. The damline has an impressive list of close relations in FEI showjumping: The stallion is a half-brother to a 1.55 m. jumper and two 1.30 - 1.35 m. CSI jumpers. The stallion's second dam is a 1.60 m. jumper. His third dam is a half-sister to a 1.60 m. jumper and three 1.40 - 1.45 m. jumpers. As a sire, he is recommended to mares with a good topline and feet, that need improvement in the canter, jumping traits, and interior qualities. He is a medium-weight stallion, but because of the stallions in his pedigree he may best suit a modern warmblood jumping-bred mare, and a mare with a thoroughbred ancestor in her 3-generation pedigree. For eventing breeding, he should suit a mare with high thoroughbred genetics, especially a thoroughbred or true half-bred mare. He is expected to contribute a good mind, a highly functional canter and rideability, and desirable jumping traits to both jumping and eventing progeny.
