3-DAY PERFORMANCE TEST OBSERVATIONS: Rectangular type with a well-developed neck, albeit slightly vertical. Withers are a bit high and long. Croup is somewhat short, but the shape is good. Stance of fore-legs is good; stance of hind-legs is slightly sickle, and they are a little long. Legs are dry and slightly fine. Walk and trot are more than sufficient. Canter has good power with a long length of stride and good elasticity; he carries himself and his rider quite well. Jumping is powerful with good use of his body. Takeoff and front-leg technique are good, while the hind-leg technique is consistently very good. He appears to have a lot of scope. He is still green under the saddle, which is expected for a three-year-old, but his rideability is more than sufficient at this time. He shows a good willingness to work and enjoys jumping. The stallion has much potential for sport and breeding, and he descends from an exceptionally good performance damline. He should suit a wide variety of showjumping and eventing mares, as he brings no real weakness with respect to conformation or movement, and his canter and jumping traits are consistently strong, fulfilling requirements for modern sport. For eventing breeding, he may best suit Thoroughbred and true half-bred mares lacking power, scope, and a good canter.
