Additional Observations by the Inspectors: The stallion is a well-developed and modern rectangular type. His neck is a bit vertical. He has a good back, and his croup is sloping. The foreleg is correct; the hindleg is a little straight but more than sufficient. His heels have improved since Stage 1. His walk and trot are correct and more than sufficient. He has a good functional canter, balanced with a long stride, and is light-footed. His jumping technique is more than sufficient to good when the fences were raised; he should show more power in the take-off. His body use is acceptable. Rideability is good, and he works willingly with the rider. He is careful. His technique and scope improved very significantly after the fences were raised and widened on the final day of the test. He jumped easily and confidently. His pedigree and damline are good. His dam has produced three foals, with the eldest born in 2018. His dam is a half-sister to many athletes including a 1.50 m. CSI jumper and eight 1.30 – 1.35 national or international jumpers. His second dam is a half-sister to two 1.40 m. CSI jumpers, four 1.30 – 1.35 m. jumpers, and six dressage horses. His third dam has similar CSI and national sport performance among her half-siblings. The first four dams have been awarded many KWPN predicates. He is a medium-weight stallion, but because of the stallions in his pedigree he may best suit a modern warmblood showjumping-bred mare, or a mare with a thoroughbred ancestor in her 3-generation pedigree. For eventing breeding, he should suit a mare with high thoroughbred genetics, including a true half-bred mare. He is expected to contribute good interior qualities, a highly functional canter and rideability, and desirable jumping traits to both jumping and eventing progeny.
