#### STAGE 3 PERFORMANCE TEST NOTES

This is a long-lined stallion with good athleticism. He has developed well and grown since his Stage 1 Inspection seven months ago, and he shows improved scores for the canter, scope, reflexes, technique, and rideability. His foreleg technique may continue to improve as fences are raised and widened in the future. His conformation is functional, and permits him to have a ground-covering canter that easily produces a jump with good scope and reflexes. He is a careful jumper with a lot of power. His rideability and willingness to work for and with the rider are good. He shows good talent as a jumping horse, and promises a very good sport career. He should be used by both showjumping and eventing breeders on mares with a modern phenotype and pedigree.
