3-DAY PERFORMANCE TEST OBSERVATIONS: This stallion has a somewhat heavy head-neck connection, and the neck is somewhat vertical and heavily muscled. He is somewhat ewe-necked. His topline is a bit weak. His croup is sloping and somewhat short. He stands under himself a bit in his forelegs. His feet are a little different. Walk has good length of stride and is correct. Trot is sufficient and is balanced with impulsion. Canter is quite powerful with good balance and length of stride. He carries himself and the rider well. Jumps with a lot of power and with a very good takeoff. Technique is consistently good in front and behind. He has a lot of athletic scope and talent as a jumping horse. He is rideable but needs to concentrate more on his rider, especially in the last stride or two before a fence. He fights for his rider, not against him, and the stallion wants to work and jump. His jumping ability compensates for the weaknesses in his conformation noted above. The stallion is suitable for both showjumping and eventing breeding. For both directions, the mare should bring good leg and feet conformation, and ideally a better canter and easier rideability. For eventing breeding, the stallion brings a lot of blood in his athletic expression, so he may suit colder mares that ideally can contribute the gallop and a good foundation.
