Consent

By submitting this Declaration of Birth and Application for Foal Registration I agree to be bound by the Rules and Procedures of the Warmblood Studbook of Ireland (available for download at <http://bit.ly/WSIRules>). I irrevocably grant to WSI ownership of the DNA sample and DNA profile, and the right to use the DNA sample and DNA profile for any purpose that benefits Irish Warmblood breeders.

A portion of the hair sample will be used to in a DAFM-funded programme to create a genotype of your horse under the control of WSI. It is a condition of DAFM funding for its Genotype Scheme that WSI obtain a signed agreement from the horse owner (client) in relation to the provision of a sample

for obtaining a genotype profile and the use of the data derived from this genotype profile. This agreement *"must permit the breed society*

- a. *to obtain Animal Data which the equine owner (as a Genomics Service user) either owns now, has previously owned or acquires in the future from various sources and to use such Animal Data in providing its services and carrying out its activities.*
- b. *to share this sample and the associated Animal Data with the organisation carrying out national breeding initiatives for the sport horse industry under contract with DAFM*
- c. *to obtain Animal Data from any source, including the equine owner, and using such Animal Data in any way and for any purpose it deems appropriate.*
- d. *to use or allow the usage of the Animal Data for research activities (including in the publication of any such research) and for providing its various services; and making the Animal Data publicly available and sharing or passing on the Animal Data to any third party it deems appropriate as part of their services it provides to industry including without limitation making the Animal Data available online on the breed society's website."*

DAFM also requires that *"(a)ll DNA profiles aided under this scheme must be made available to other DAFM recognised breed societies on request for use of parentage verification and shall not be limited to the current year of testing."*

I attest that the horse is not registered with any other Passport Issuing Authority. I attest that the identifying veterinary surgeon checked for any previously implanted transponder before implanting a transponder. If a previously implanted transponder were found, I attest that the equine has not been registered with any other Passport Issuing Organisation.

I understand that to comply with the law WSI must obtain, record, and store information about my name, postal address, email address, telephone number and Equine Registered Premises Number. I understand that WSI must share this information with the Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine (DAFM). This information must be held by WSI for a period of at least 35 years or at least 2 years from the date of communication of the equine's death. Information about my horse will be held in perpetuity. For the sole purpose of payment for a horse registration I consent to WSI obtaining my credit/debit card details for one-time processing of the fee. I understand that the credit/debit card details will not be recorded or stored by WSI.

I understand that I have the right to access my information held by WSI, to have any inaccuracies corrected, and to have my information deleted if WSI is not required by the law to retain the information. I understand that I can withdraw this consent at any time by emailing the Studbook Administrator at admin@irish-warmblood.com and communicating my withdrawal of consent for WSI to hold any information except information that is required by law to be retained for the period mentioned above. I give WSI permission to obtain and use the DNA profile of the horse I wish to register, his dam, and his sire, and I authorize the studbooks that control the DNA profile of these horses to share them with WSI.
