I understand that I have the right to access my information held by WSI, to have any inaccuracies corrected, and to have my information deleted if WSI is not required by the law to retain the information.

I understand that I can withdraw this consent at any time by emailing the Studbook Administrator at admin@irish-warmblood.com and communicating my withdrawal of consent for WSI to hold any information except information that is required by law to be retained for the period mentioned above.
